Our Comprehensive Campaign Continues to Escalate

- Since our strike vote, our community allies are taking stronger action to pressure UC
- Dozens of Politicians and community leaders have begun intervening with the University
- President Bill Clinton, retired General Wesley Clark, Robert Kennedy Jr., Congressmembers Waxman and Solis, former Speaker of Assembly Fabian Nunez, Assemblymembers John Laird and Fiona Ma, Angela Davis, Arianna Huffington and many notable professors have canceled their planned graduation speeches in support of a fair contract for UC workers!

We're Back at the PCT Bargaining Table, Nothing New in SX:

- May 17-22nd, the PCT unit voted down the last proposal from UC because it still left us far behind other hospital workers
- We have PCT negotiations scheduled on June 17th
- May 17-22nd, the SX unit voted down a proposal with no guaranteed raises for service workers or real longevity based steps
- UC is holding out on the service workers contract because they are using us to try to get more money in the state budget but refusing to guarantee that any of it would actually come to us
- They say we are dependent on state funding but we know only 8.6% of AFSCME workers' funding comes from the state

UC is Worried About a Strike

- UC has hired an anti-union law firm and is setting up hurdles to try to discourage us
- Our plan attacks UC from all sides
- We will continue to expand our fight until we get the contracts we deserve!
