Assemblyman Dymally and Lieutenant Governor Garamendi walked the picket line with workers outside, in addition to advocating for us inside.



After picketing outside UCLA Medical Center, Senator Romero led a delegation on UCLA Administration. Romero assured UC that if there is not an immediate resolution of our contract dispute, she will be back!
