Patient Care Technical Ratifies Historic Contract By 99% Pressure Mounts on UC to Agree To Same for Service

Thousand of members cast "YES" votes to overwhelming ratify a contract by 99%. After more than a year of negotiations and actions, highlights of the new PCT contract include:

- Automatic longevity based step system
- Minimum of 18% ATB increases over the life of the contract and 2% equity
- Pension and Healthcare protections
- Caps on parking rate increases
- Improved seniority rights around scheduling, promotions and OT
- Much More!

This victory shows that our actions are working and UC is giving in to our demands—but the fight is not over yet! Service workers have also been fighting for a year are still without a contract and struggle everyday to support their families on UC's poverty wages.

In support of a fair contract for service workers, thousands of Patient Care workers wore stickers on vote day to send the message to management: "Even though the Patient Care contract has been settled, we will not stop the fight until Service workers get a fair deal too!"
