Kathryn Lybarger *Lead Gardener, UCB, Slate:* Unity 4 All

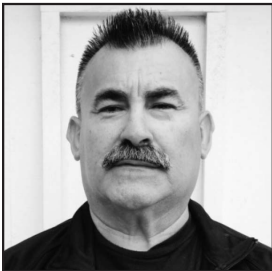

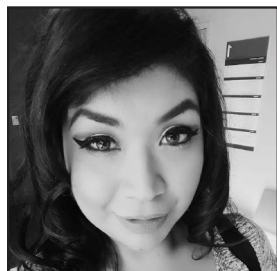


Lakeisha Collins *Nutrition/Cook, Slate: Unity 4 All*
